Or even if you have the skills, you may lack the consistent time or energy – due to work, family, health issues or other obligations – that your horse requires to make meaningful progress.

The focus of the All-Around program is to first establish a solid foundation, then rapidly build on that foundation; advancing and refining your horse's skills until the final day of the program.

During the first 4 weeks, groundwork and riding exercises designed to earn your horse's trust and respect – while correcting bad habits and behavioral issues – set the cornerstone for a safe and enjoyable partnership.

Once this foundation is established, the second half of the program aims to teach and refine more advanced maneuvers and concepts that are tailored to your horse's abilities and your personal horsemanship goals.

Who is this Program For?

The All-Around program is designed for re-training problem horses, tuning up older horses that may have holes in their training, or starting green horses in need of a solid foundation for their career. It's an intensive program, and we get positive results quickly. There's a reason why we call it a "boot camp for horses."



<u>For Problem Horses:</u> No matter what the source of your horse's problems, our program is the answer to earning his respect and trust. If you don't want to give up on your horse, then our boot camp-like training program is the solution.

For Green Colts or Horses Needing a Tune Up: We dedicate 2 ½ hours a day, 6 days a week to each horse in training; developing them into safe and respectful partners. Your horse will learn essential groundwork exercises, be ridden in the arena, on the trail, with other horses and worked extensively over obstacles. By the end of his training, your horse will have a great foundation in place for you to build on and and excel in the future discipline of your choice.

What Else Is Included?

Progress Updates Every 2 Weeks

Jake or Amy will contact you at 2-week intervals to give you an in-depth recap of your horse's progress through the program. You won't have to worry about where your horse is at in the program, or if he's had any health or soundness issues during his stay, because you'll always be in the loop.

Even if everything is on track and your horse is 100% healthy, you'll still get an update call at minimum every 2 weeks. Each phone call will be followed up by an email summary of the conversation; making sure that everyone is on the same page and nothing is forgotten.

Free Full-Day Lesson Upon Completion

Once your horse has completed the 8-Week training program, you'll be invited to spend an entire day with Jake or Amy as they walk you through all the groundwork and riding exercises your "new" horse knows.

This is our chance to show off what we've accomplished. It's also your chance to ask questions and let us help you refine your skills as a horseman. You'll work with your horse in the arena, on the obstacle course and on the trail to ensure you thoroughly understand how he's been trained and you are both in tune with each other. How Does This Work?

Step 1 – The Interview

Once you've expressed interest in sending your horse to Lundahl Performance, your horse's enrollment in the training program is dependent upon a telephone interview. This is to ensure the program is suitable for both you and the needs of your horse, and if so, to determine a firm start date for your horse's training.

Step 2 – Deposit and Training Fee

Upon acceptance and enrollment into the program you'll receive an invoice for a \$500 deposit which will be applied to your horse's training fee. The complete program fee (\$4,000) plus board is due prior to the actual start of your horse's training session.

Step 3 - Confirm Arrival Date

Next, you'll receive an email from us confirming the date and time that your horse will arrive at Lundahl Performance. Two weeks prior to the actual start of your horse's training session you'll receive a telephone call from the trainer assigned to your horse to ensure everything is still on track for your horse's arrival.

Step 4 - The Training Begins

Then your horse arrives and his training session begins. Throughout the training program period you can expect to receive a telephone call every 2 weeks to update you and discuss your horse's progress.

Step 5 - Scheduling Your Lesson

Your lesson and pick-up date for your horse will be scheduled 2 weeks in advance of the program completion date; to allow you to make the necessary arrangements.

Step 6 - Your Final Invoice

Approximately 1 week prior to your lesson and pick-up date you'll receive a final invoice from us for any incidentals such as, but not limited to, farrier, medications, and additional board if applicable.

Step 7 – Your Lesson Day

Last but not least, you'll experience one full day of lessons with your trainer, before taking your horse home to enjoy!
